

IOSH Safety for Senior Executives Training

Description

A one-day course for senior executives who want to ensure that they are aware of their responsibilities and the implications of failing to manage health and safety effectively, including the latest legal developments.

Aims

Establish a clear understanding of the moral, financial and legal implications of health and safety in the workplace.

Course content

The day covers a range of topics:

- Current legislation including:
 - changes in law to emphasise a non-prescriptive approach, based on risk assessment in terms of best practice
 - penalties that could be imposed for contravention of legislation
 - the concept of corporate manslaughter.
- Health and safety as a main line-management function.
- The financial implications of accidents and ill-health caused by working conditions.
- The root cause of accidents.
- The principles of risk assessment.
- The need for a documented health and safety management system.

On completion of the course, delegates are required to complete an assessment of their understanding. Successful delegates will be awarded a certificate by IOSH.

Who should attend?

This course is relevant for directors, senior executives and managers across all industry sectors.
