

IOSH Practical Techniques for Managing Health and Safety Training

Description

Practical Techniques for Managing Health and Safety is designed to equip managers and others in control of workplaces with knowledge of the key skills which are necessary to enable them to effectively manage health and safety and to introduce changes to make their organisation operate more safely. The course is based upon best practice modules for managing health and safety (HSG65 and ISO 18001).

Aims

To ensure that key managers are aware of the basic components of a successful health and safety management system designed to comply with either HSG 65 or ISO 18001 standards.

Course content

The course consists of four key modules.

- Policy and organisation.
- Planning and setting standards.
- Measuring performance.
- Audit and review.

The course is interactive using practical exercises to provide delegates with the confidence, skills and techniques necessary to successfully devise and implement effective health and safety systems and the controls needed within their businesses.

Who should attend?

Directors, Managers and others with responsibilities for employee health and safety.

Duration

The duration of the course is two full days and in order for an IOSH certificate to be issued, delegates will need to successfully complete IOSH's assessment procedures.
