It helps ensure that disqualified (and therefore uninsured) drivers are not making work-related journeys and allows you to manage at-risk drivers.</p>
Management Information System (MIS)	<p>The Management Information System (MIS) stores all of the information collected from the modules above. It allows the data stored to be managed efficiently and effectively.</p>	<p>It provides technically honest recommendations to control the risks, ranked in order of elimination, substitution or reduction. Managers can monitor the drivers' completion of the modules.</p>
