

The Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations and Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 - 2025

Description

The Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulation and Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations cover the responsibilities of persons placing lifting equipment and other work equipment into the workplace. This legislation has been in place since the 1990s, however recent revisions have been made to the LOLER and PUWER ACOPs and Guidance Notes.

The course explains the legislation and where it interfaces with Machinery and Lift Supply Regulations.

Users will be given a general understanding of the regulations, explaining their responsibilities and the scope of the regulations.

Aims

To understand the requirements of LOLER and PUWER for those persons providing lifting equipment into the workplace and having control of lifts and lifting equipment.

Course Content

- History of the regulations
- Overview of the regulations, including:
 - LOLER
 - PUWER
 - Working at Height Regulations
 - Supply of Machinery (Safety) Regulations.
 - The Lift Regulations.
 - Incidents and failures.

Works engineers / managers involved in the provision of Lifting Equipment in the workplace or persons being in control of lifts and lifting equipment.

The course is also relevant to those with Health and Safety responsibilities.
