



The context in which organisations are operating is constantly changing and becoming more challenging. Zurich Municipal recently carried out customer research in conjunction with YouGov, on current and future changes in the public and voluntary sectors. The research explored general sentiment about the future of the public and voluntary sectors; views on current and future drivers of change and their relative impact; and future challenges and opportunities and how well-placed organisations are to deal with them.

Our respondents reported that in the last five years change has been largely reactive, exacerbated by the COVID-19 and financial pressures.


