NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE that a petition (the **Petition**) has been presented to the High Court of Ireland (the **Court**) seeking approval for a scheme for the transfer of part of the non-life assurance business of Zurich Insurance plc (**ZIP**), having its registered office at Zurich House, Ballsbridge Park, Dublin 4, D04 E5N4, Ireland to East West Insurance Company Limited (**EWICL**), having its registered office in the United Kingdom at 20 Old Broad Street, London, EC2N 1DP (the **Scheme**). The business which is proposed to transfer under the Scheme consists of insurance policies which provide cover for the benefit of homeowners against damage caused by structural and other defects attributable to the manner in which their homes were constructed and certain other risks (the **UKBG Policies**).

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that a copy of this Notice, the Petition (incorporating the said Scheme) and the report of an Independent Actuary on the Scheme will be available for inspection by the policyholders and shareholders of ZIP and EWICL at their respective registered offices and at ZIP's UK branch office at 70 Mark Lane, London, EC3R 7NQ, United Kingdom between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on each working day from the date hereof until the date that the said Petition is to be heard by the Court (both dates inclusive). Copies of the said documents will also be made available for viewing on the following websites: www.zurich.co.uk/buildingguaranteetransfer and www.armorholdings.com/client-resources/transfer-of-the-zurich-uk-building-guarantee-business/. Any person who cannot access those websites can request copies of the documents to be posted to them, free of charge, by contacting ZIP in the manner set out at the end of this Notice.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the said Petition is to be heard by the Court on 14 March 2018 at the Four Courts in the city of Dublin, Ireland, at 11.00am. Any person who wishes to be heard at the hearing of the said Petition and any person who objects to the proposed Scheme but does not intend to appear at the said hearing should give notice in writing of such intention or objection and the reasons therefor to A&L Goodbody Solicitors at, International Financial Services Centre, North Wall Quay, Dublin 1, Ireland (Ref: EAM/JN), such notice to arrive no later than 5.00pm on 8 March 2018. Any person wishing to make submissions at the hearing of the Petition or rely on evidence at the said hearing should file an affidavit with the Court setting out those submissions or the evidence on which they propose to rely and serve a copy of that affidavit on A&L Goodbody at the aforementioned address quoting our reference EAM/JN, to arrive no later than 5.00pm on 8 March 2018.
